WELCOME TO THE EPIPHANY SEASON

The day of Epiphany is always January 6, twelve days after Christmas Day. The Epiphany season continues through Transfiguration Sunday, which always occurs on the Sunday before Ash Wednesday. So what do we do with Epiphany? Why does it show up on our church calendar? What difference does this season make for my life?



- The word “epiphany” means “manifestation.” In our Christian vocabulary we use it to celebrate the arrival of Jesus into the human world. God was suddenly revealing Himself to us.
- We start the Epiphany season by watching the Wise Men (Magi) come from the East. They saw the light of the star and followed it to see the baby Jesus being revealed.
- Each of the Gospel readings for the season gives us an additional frame of the slideshow of light that Jesus brings into our lives.

Jesus is the light of the world. Let him shine more brightly in your life as the next six Sundays unfold.

COS SAFETY SECURITY REVIEW

We are all aware of recent mass shootings in our nation. Some of those have occurred in churches. This situation stirs fear in our hearts, and it prompted a Church Council meeting discussion of our safety at COS. Here is a summary of relevant information. We all need to be aware of resources we have for facing emergencies.

1. The main entrance door is locked during worship. A volunteer in the hallway will open for late-comers.
2. The media center has a landline phone for immediate contact to first responders in case of emergency.
3. **Exits Available:** We have outside access through the main entrance by the offices, the double doors to the parking lot from the Sanctuary, a single door between the organ and the choir risers, and a single door to the East next to the nursery room door.
4. **Tornado shelter:** The best places to go are the youth room or the music room. No windows to break.
5. **Equipment on hand:** We have a defibrillator on the wall across from the kitchen entrance. First aid kits are in the kitchen and the media center.
6. **Fire/smoke alarms** are located throughout the building. They are inspected regularly.

We can all take a few simple steps to assist each other in maintaining our mutual safety. Please help. The steel double doors from the sanctuary to the parking lot may appear to be closed but may not be latched. Check them from the outside. Do not leave the kitchen doors ajar or prop them open.

If we have a fire, close doors behind you when you leave, including the door over the “pass through” counter in the kitchen.
