- As Lutherans we follow the Confessions as a proper interpretation of the Bible.

Where do we as a congregation fit on that road? We need consensus on the meaning and application of our teaching on these subjects.

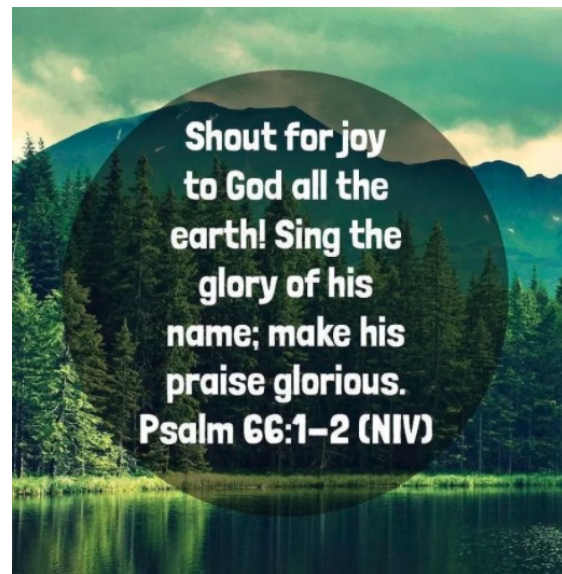

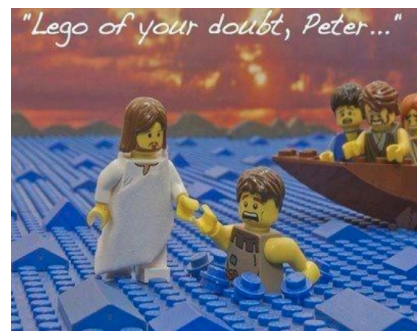
