

flesh, fearful of withering under the heat of opposition from the society around us. We have not always trusted Your abiding Word. Forgive us, good

Pastor: O Holy Spirit, we give thanks that, as our Lord was discerned in the breaking of

the bread, so You use Word and Sacrament to work and sustain faith in the hearts

of all believers.

People: We confess that we have not always valued the promises of our Baptism.

Forgive us, good Lord.

Pastor: Rejoice and be glad! Our gracious Savior is with us today as surely as He was in

Emmaus. The Holy Spirit continues to strengthen us as we follow the apostles' footsteps. You have been redeemed by the blood of Christ; therefore, as a called and ordained servant of Christ and by His authority, I forgive you all your sins in

the name of the Father and of the

▼ PRAYER OF THE CHURCH ▼

Pastor: Let us pray for people around the world in their various needs, their nations and leaders, the Church wherever it proclaims Christ, and ourselves in this place.

Pastor: "All flesh is like grass," and so, Lord Jesus, we ask You to strengthen and preserve all who call out to You with illnesses or disabilities, in sorrow and mourning, from isolation and fear, [including . . .]. Surround them with caring health care professionals, understanding counselors, and concerned circles of family and friends. Bring about the health, relief, and joy You have in mind for them. Lord, in Your mercy,

People: hear our prayer.

Pastor: We pray for ourselves, on whom You have bestowed faith, O Holy Spirit. Strengthen our faith, that, with the disciples of Emmaus, our hearts may burn within us as we study the Word and gather for the breaking of the bread. Keep us strong in the faith, so that we may share it with the people around us, that they, too, may rejoice in the salvation our risen Lord offers to all. Lord, in Your mercy,

People: hear our prayer.

Pastor: These and any other things You would have us ask of You, grant to us, heavenly Father, for the sake of Your Son, Jesus Christ, our Lord.
